

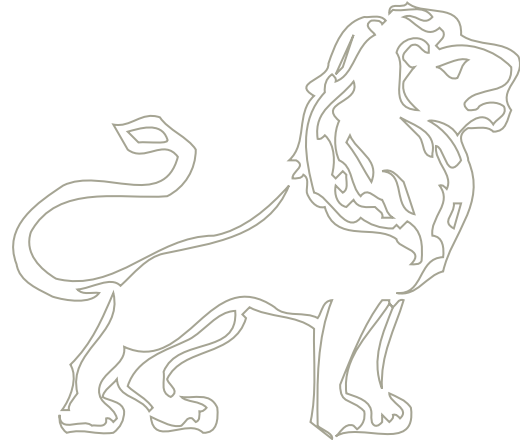

Vintage: 2014 was a near-perfect growing season with welcomed spring rains and warm summer months. The good weather held out through harvest season and the smaller, intensely flavored Cabernet Sauvignon grapes were harvested from mid-September to October 12th.

Wine: The fruit was hand sorted and fermented in small lots at an average of 85°F with gentle pump-overs for excellent flavor and color extraction. The Petit Verdot brings flashes of muscle to the blend and the Malbec rounds it out with more ripe black fruit flavors.

Notes: This 2014 Cabernet balances bright flavors and aromas with rich structure, weight, and texture. The wine bursts with a complex array of aromas including fresh blueberries, huckleberry pie, crème de cassis, bay leaf, clove, licorice, and toasted almonds. On the palate, there is a strong presence of baked blackberry cobbler, black cherries, graphite, dried sage, sweet cedar, and nuances of toasted walnuts. These flavors hold through the mid-palate and finish with firm and chewy tannins. It is enjoyable now and will continue to evolve through 2025 and beyond.
